Safety Rules for Range Use

This safety plan has been established to insure the health and safety of those individuals who use or frequent this facility and the community at large. It is a plan developed to assure the continuity of this facility through a concerted public relations effort.

Gun Handling Rules

1. Always point the muzzle in a safe direction.
2. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
3. Always keep the gun unloaded until ready to use.
4. Know how the firearm operates.
5. Be sure the firearm and ammunition are compatible.
6. Carry only one gauge/caliber of ammunition when shooting. When at a shooting range with more than one firearm, use one at a time and when complete, store that firearm and its ammunition before using the next one.
7. Be sure of your target and what is beyond.
8. Wear ear and eye protection.
9. Do not mix alcohol or drugs with shooting activities.
10. Be aware that certain types of guns and many shooting activities require additional safety precautions.

General Range Rules

1. Know and obey all range commands.
2. Know where others are at all times.
3. Shoot only at authorized targets.
4. Never place a target on the ground or shoot at a target on the ground. Place any objects you use as targets on the berm supports.
5. Designate a range officer when none is present or assigned.
6. Unload, open the action, remove the magazine and ground and/or bench all firearms during a cease-fire.
7. Do not handle any firearm or stand at the firing line when firearms are present while others are down range.
8. Always keep the muzzle pointed at the backstop. Never allow the muzzle to point in any direction whereby an inadvertent discharge would allow the escape of a projectile into an outer area.
9. On the shooting range no targets may be used which will cover any portion of the wood uprights or the wood crosspieces. All targets must be placed so that the target berms are well within your line of fire.
10. All breakable targets must be biodegradable.
11. Please clean up when done.

I understand and will comply with the above Gun Handling Rules and General Range Rules. I further understand that any actions that I take that comprises my safety, the safety of Range Personal or other participants can result in my expulsion from the range and today's activities.
